A. CALL TO ORDER & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Wytoski called the meeting to order at 6:34 pm and those present gave the Pledge of Allegiance.

B. ROLL CALL

Mayor Wytoski noted there was a quorum with Councilors Bixler, Collins, Mackin, Marquez, and Price. Mayor Wytoski noted the absence of Councilor McGraw.

C. APPEARANCE OF INTERESTED CITIZENS

D. CONSENT AGENDA

DARRICK PRICE MOVED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF MAY 7, 2018, AND REGULAR SESSION MINUTES OF JUNE 4, 2018, AND WORKING/SPECIAL/EXECUTIVE SESSION MINUTES OF JUNE 18, 2018 AS AMENDED. SECONDED BY TRINI MARQUEZ. Motion carried with Bixler, Collins, Mackin, Marquez, Price and Wytoski voting aye. McGraw absent.

E. ACTION ITEMS

1. Safe Roads to School Grant Discussion/9th to Flower Sidewalk Improvements

Mayor Wytoski gave an overview of the proposed project. Discussion followed. No action was taken at this meeting.

2. Staffing Discussion/Approval of Interim City Manager Contract

Mayor Wytoski reviewed the new Interim City Manager's Contract and the need to hire more

office staff. After discussion it was agreed to review the hiring options for the City Manager position after the Interim City Manager's 4 month review and that there is a need to hire more permanent staff at this time.

MAYOR WYTOSKI MOVED TO ALLOW THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER AUTHORIZATION TO HIRE A TEMPORARY FULL TIME EMPLOYEE. SECONDED BY JOHN COLLINS. Motion carried with Bixler, Collins, Mackin, Marquez, Price and Wytoski voting aye. McGraw absent.

3. Food Vendors/Special Events/Fee Discussion

Mayor Wytoski reviewed the need to re-address certain aspects of Section 3.11 Food Trucks and Push Carts of the Dayton Municipal Code. Discussion clarified that general "food vendors" were not intended to be included in the food truck and push cart code. Discussion regarding business registration requirements and special event Code will need to be addressed at a later date. No decision was made regarding setting fees for food trucks and push carts.

F. CITY COUNCIL COMMENTS AND CONCERNS

Trini Marquez asked when the sewer project would be done. Discussion followed.

John Collins addressed homeless camping in Courthouse Square Park, stating that the Park bathroom doors open and close in the early morning hours.

Mayor Wytoski stated that the City of Keizer has been working on a homeless initiative that changes the way homelessness is looked at and addresses the associated issues. She also stated that invitations to the Volcano's baseball game were emailed to several residents in the City of Dayton for tonight's game.

Mayor Wytoski reviewed the City Manger's report in the Interim City Manager's absence.
