TITLE: *A Resolution of the City of Dayton Declaring the City as an Innovate Oregon city in partnership with the Technology Association of Oregon (TAO).*

WHEREAS, Digital technologies are transforming every sector of the economy; and

WHEREAS, Long-term competitive advantage for all organizations is increasingly being defined by their rate of innovation; and

WHEREAS, To quickly develop and deliver new value, organizations need talent that not only has technical skill sets but also innovation mindsets; and

WHEREAS, The City wishes to ignite a culture of creative problem solving and empower the next generation of innovators; and

WHEREAS, The City has been working to align support efforts in the schools and business community to build an inclusive innovation-based economy in Dayton; and

WHEREAS, The Technology Association of Oregon has launched Innovate Oregon to help the state prepare the workforce of the next generation.

Therefore, the City of Dayton resolves as follows:

- 1) **THAT** the City of Dayton joins with the Technology Association of Oregon as an Innovate Oregon city; and
- 2) **THAT** the City will join with TAO to continue to foster a culture of innovation within local schools, businesses and government, and to align the community with TAO's statewide efforts.
- 3) **THAT** this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
