For the week of April 12th, 2021, Yamhill County as a whole is expected to receive 2,000 first doses of vaccine.

Please see breakdown of distribution below:

- Directly to YCPH: 1700
- Directly to primary care providers: 300
- We did not receive the allocation numbers for pharmacies receiving doses from the federal government this week.

300 doses that are sent directly to YCPH will be pushed to primary care providers. We are scheduled to give all 1,700 doses within one week of receiving them.

On Friday, April 9th, OHA announced that Yamhill County will begin a 2 week caution period before moving into moderate risk if case numbers do not decrease. This provides a reminder to our community to continue wearing a face covering, washing your hands often, maintaining 6 foot distance from those outside of your household, avoiding large groups and to get the vaccine when you are able.

Yamhill County continues to use the Get Vaccinated Oregon (GVO) tool which can be found [here](#) for our vaccine registration process. This tool tells individuals if they are currently eligible to receive a vaccine, allows individuals to register even if they are not currently eligible, signs them up to receive important vaccine eligibility updates, helps to create an account and find a vaccination provider, alerts individuals and gives instructions on how to schedule. People who are already registered with the Oregon GVO tool do not need to register again.

Yamhill County Public Health also continues to partner with Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue, McMinnville Fire Department, Providence Medical Group, West Valley Fire District, Sunrise Family Clinic, Willamette Valley Medical Center, YCAP, Unidos and Virginia Garcia to facilitate vaccine clinics. These clinics allow a greater number of eligible individuals to get vaccinated each week.
