## ORDINANCE NO. 634 CITY OF DAYTON, OREGON

An Ordinance Amending the Telecommunications Franchise Granted to McMinnville Access Company to Use City Rights of Way to Provide Telecommunications Services

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2015, by Ordinance No. 624, the City granted McMinnville Access Company, doing business as Online Northwest ("McMinnville Access"), a franchise pursuant to Chapter 6 of the Dayton Municipal Code (the "Franchise"), which governs the construction and franchising of telecommunications carriers operating within the City and desiring to occupy City rights of way; and

WHEREAS, the Franchise authorizes McMinnville Access to occupy the rights of way in the City only to provide telecommunications services, as that term is defined in Chapter 6; and

WHEREAS, McMinnville Access intends to provide services over its facilities in the City that are not covered in the definition of "telecommunications services" in Chapter 6, and has requested an amendment to the Franchise to authorize these services; and

WHEREAS, City has reviewed McMinnville Access's request and finds that it is in the public interest to authorize the company to provide additional services in the City, and the City Council therefore desires to amend the Franchise to authorize these services.

## The City of Dayton Ordains as follows:

Section 1. The City of Dayton hereby amends Section 1(d) of the Franchise with McMinnville Access as follows (deletions shown as strikethrough; additions are underlined): "The terms 'telecommunications facilities," "telecommunications services," 'rights of way' and any other term used in this franchise that is defined in Chapter 6.11 of the Dayton Municipal Code shall have the meaning set forth therein; provided, however, that notwithstanding the definition of 'telecommunications services' in Chapter 6.11, for purposes of this franchise 'telecommunications services' shall mean 'any service provided for the purpose of transmission of information, including, but not limited to, voice, video, or data, and includes all forms of telephone services and voice, video, data or information transport, but does not include 'cable service' as that term is defined in the Cable Act."

Section 2. All other provisions, terms and conditions of the Franchise remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as expressly stated herein.

Section 3. The amendments to the Franchise granted herein are conditioned upon McMinnville Access's acceptance of the amended terms and conditions in writing in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A within thirty (30) days of City Council enactment of this Ordinance. In the event McMinnville Access fails to timely file the acceptance, this Ordinance shall be null and void.
